All sorts of topics are covered in The Sparkles, and sometimes there are articles about jobs similar to yours. For your particular interest we have put together this special Daily Sparkle which has some articles connected to your type of role in days gone by - days when the home's residents were in their 20s and 30s. I hope you enjoy reading them.

As I mentioned above, The Daily Sparkle is a cure for loneliness. Using The Daily Sparkle, care home staff can find articles that are of interest to them and then use those articles to start a conversation with individual residents. Chatting to residents doesn't need to cost you time. It can just happen as you go about your day.

There are Carers' Notes on the back page which give a bit of background information about the articles. There are also prompts and questions which you can use to get chatting with residents. Every time you interact with residents you make a real and positive difference to that resident's feeling of belonging and connection.

Each month we also make a list of articles that will be featured in the coming month's Daily Sparkles. It would be great if you could check whether there are any articles that are about your particular role. For example, if you are the chef, there might be an article about a popular type of ovenware that was used in the 1950's. This can then be an opportunity to chat with residents about that article.
